Summary for April 2018

21 alerts posted reporting on 20 outbreaks/cases*

- **Eastern Equine Encephalitis:** 2 cases (FL)
- **Equine Herpesvirus:** 6 outbreaks (WA, SD, CA, ND, CO, WY)
- **Strangles:** 10 outbreaks (9 in FL, 1 in MI)
- **Equine Infectious Anemia:** 2 cases (1 in IA, 1 in TX)

Totals in 2018

103 alerts posted reporting on 85 outbreaks/cases*

- **Eastern Equine Encephalitis:** 10 cases (FL)
- **Equine Herpesvirus:** 36 outbreaks (3 in AZ, 2 in CA, 1 in CO, 4 in ID, 3 in KY, 2 in MD, 1 in MI, 1 in ND, 1 in NJ, 2 in NY, 2 in OH, 1 in OR, 4 in PA, 1 in SD, 4 in VA, 2 in WA, 2 in WY)
- **Equine Infectious Anemia:** 6 cases (1 in AB-CAN, 1 in IA, 4 in TX)
- **Equine Influenza:** 2 outbreaks (GA and AZ)
- **Strangles:** 31 outbreaks (1 in CA, 24 in FL, 2 in GA, 3 in MI, 1 in VA)

EDCC Totals (as of May 1st, 2018)

- 798 alerts posted since April 2015
- 984 outbreaks reported since April 2015
- 4,764 addresses on the EDCC email alert subscription list
- 6,679 following on Facebook

***Note:** “Alerts” refers to email messages sent out by EDCC. Each alert can contain information on more than one case/outbreak/quarantine. “Case” refers to disease in one individual horse. “Outbreak” refers to the index case(s) of an infectious disease and the total number of cases may be unknown. “Quarantine” refers to an outbreak of infectious disease and the number of horses quarantined may be unknown.
